

Key Health Sector Policy & Infrastructure News

- **National health vision & universal care** — The Government of India outlined its ambition to transform India into a **global health powerhouse**, emphasizing universal health coverage, expanded ayushman schemes, and stronger public health systems.
- **AI & healthcare discourse** — Experts at a medical event stressed that **Artificial Intelligence (AI)** should augment, not replace, doctors, highlighting its role in patient monitoring, screening, and decision-support systems.
- **New AYUSH medical institute planned** — The Chandigarh administration has allocated land for an **integrated AYUSH medical institute** to promote traditional systems like Ayurveda, Unani and Siddha alongside conventional care.
- **Treatment access expansion for rare disorders** — The Odisha government has rolled out specialized drugs for rare blood disorders, targeting conditions like thalassemia and hemophilia.

Healthcare Facilities & Services

- **Specialist hospital expansion** — A new 50-bed facility opened in Hyderabad to enhance urology and nephrology services.
- **Critical care upgrade in Delhi** — A new 10-bed ICU and advanced endoscopy suite were inaugurated at a major Delhi public hospital, improving critical and diagnostic care infrastructure.
- **Advanced hypertension care center** — A partnership between Gleneagles Hospital Mumbai and Medtronic India aims to set up a specialized hypertension management center using Renal Denervation Therapy.

Strategic Policy & Sector Trends

- **Biomedical research focus** — A national conference (Medical Colleges Research Connect 2026) brought together over 100 medical institutions to strengthen research capacity and collaboration.
- **Expanded PG medical seats** — The National Medical Commission has increased postgraduate seats by thousands, particularly in high-demand specialties like medicine and obstetrics, shaping counselling rounds.
- **Healthcare financing talks** — The Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority (IRDAI) plans joint insurer–hospital talks to address rising health insurance complaints and improve claim processes.
- **Large pharma expansion** — A ₹2,300 crore pharmaceutical manufacturing facility is under development in Andhra Pradesh to boost drug production and jobs.
- **Strengthening medical colleges** — Himachal Pradesh announced a ₹1,000 crore plan to expand Hamirpur Medical College with a cancer hospital and allied colleges.

- **Medical tourism boom** — India’s medical tourism industry is projected to nearly **double to USD 13 billion in 2026**, driven by quality services and cost advantages in major cities.
