

## 1. AI-based ICU services launched in Uttar Pradesh

- The Uttar Pradesh government announced AI-supported **super-speciality ICU services** in Prayagraj hospitals.
- A **hub-and-spoke telemedicine model** will link hospitals for real-time monitoring and specialist consultations.
- Services will include **cardiology, neurology, nephrology, gastroenterology, and critical care**, potentially benefiting about **1.4 crore people** in the region.

## 2. Telangana government warns private hospitals over transplant costs

- Telangana Health Minister raised concerns about **private hospitals overcharging organ-failure patients** for transplant procedures.
- The government is reviewing pricing and regulatory compliance in transplant services.

## 3. India sends humanitarian medical aid to Madagascar
