

1. Supreme Court ruling on passive euthanasia

- The **Supreme Court of India** delivered a significant ruling allowing **withdrawal of life-sustaining treatment in certain irreversible medical cases**.
- The decision came in the **Harish Rana case**, where a patient had remained in a coma for over a decade.
- The judgment strengthens the legal framework for **passive euthanasia and end-of-life care decisions in India**, requiring strict medical and legal oversight.

2. Medical camps organised for World Glaucoma Day

- The **Indian Army** conducted **free eye screening and treatment camps** in Bishnupur district of **Manipur**.
- The camps aimed to **raise awareness about glaucoma and prevent avoidable blindness** by encouraging early diagnosis and treatment.

3. Lifestyle diseases rising among young Indians

- Doctors reported a **rapid increase in high uric acid levels among people in their 20s and 30s**.
- Sedentary lifestyle, unhealthy diet, and obesity are key causes, leading to **gout and kidney stones** at younger ages than previously seen.

4. NMC advisory on mental health in medical colleges

- The **National Medical Commission** issued a directive requiring **medical colleges to report student suicides monthly and strengthen mental-health support systems**.

- Institutions must ensure **counselling services, anti-ragging measures, and 24/7 emergency support** to address rising mental-health concerns among medical students.

5. New hospital systems to improve patient care

- **King George's Medical University** in **Lucknow** is planning a system to **deliver prescribed medicines directly to patients' beds**.
- The initiative aims to **reduce long queues for attendants and prevent treatment delays** in large government hospitals.

6. Hospital operations affected by LPG supply issues

- Some government hospitals in cities such as **Madurai** and **Bengaluru** have activated contingency plans due to **shortage of commercial LPG cylinders**.
- Hospitals are shifting to **alternative cooking methods or menu changes** to ensure uninterrupted food supply for patients.
