

Health & Outbreaks

- **Guillain-Barré Syndrome (GBS) signals in Madhya Pradesh** – Local health authorities are monitoring increased cases linked to contaminated water ingestion, with officials urging hygiene to prevent infections.
- **Mpox variant research in India** – Scientists identified an evolving *Clade 1b* Mpox strain in Kerala, with several cases linked to foreign travel and evidence of human-to-human spread, underscoring strengthening surveillance needs.
- **Chickenpox rising in Kerala district** – Ernakulam reported 228 cases by 18 Jan, mostly among children, though no severe complications yet.

Healthcare Workforce & Systems

- **Doctors in Kerala announce strike** – Government medical college doctors plan indefinite strike from 2 Feb over pay and allowances, affecting non-emergency services and teaching duties.
- **Government support for medical students** – Tamil Nadu Health Ministry distributed laptops to over 1,500 medical and allied health students to improve digital access in education.
- **Vice President on medical institutions** – VP CP Radhakrishnan highlighted the vital role of both private and public medical colleges in advancing national health goals.
- **Ragging action in Uttarakhand medical college** – Nine MBBS students at Doon Medical College faced disciplinary measures in a ragging incident — reflecting ongoing student safety focus.
