



## Key Health System & Public Health Updates

- **AIIMS Raipur launches digital drug tracking system (AUSHADHI-ER)** — A new web-based inventory platform was launched to improve medicine availability and streamline emergency care operations at AIIMS Raipur, reducing manual stock errors and enhancing clinical transparency.
- **Karnataka issues seasonal influenza preparedness norms** — The state health department issued influenza guidelines to districts, calling for enhanced influenza-like illness (ILI) surveillance, lab testing, antiviral stockpiles, PPE, and public awareness to manage expected peak winter flu cases.
- **Health awareness campaign emphasizes preventive care** — At a seminar and awareness camp, speakers highlighted that public health awareness is a foundational pillar for a healthy nation, underscoring community-level education and prevention.



## Innovation & Research

- **‘Smart pill’ that samples gut microbiome inside the intestine** — Scientists from IIT Delhi and AIIMS New Delhi successfully tested an ingestible diagnostic pill capable of directly sampling gut bacteria, potentially transforming digestive disease diagnostics and deepening microbiome research.



## Controversies & Health Governance

- **Concern over unproven infection-control “anti-infective bed mats”** — Mumbai’s BMC has procured bed cover mats intended for infection control without WHO approval or clinical evidence, prompting criticism from medical experts about efficacy and scientific oversight in healthcare procurement.



## Broader Context & Ongoing Health Issues in India

Here are important related developments that continue to shape India’s health landscape (relevant around Dec 22 2025):

- **Healthcare access expanding to underserved populations** — Government officials highlight improved reach of health services to poorer communities through schemes like Ayushman Bharat and expanded medical infrastructure.
- **Emphasis on strengthening medical education & workforce** — Health leaders urge new medical graduates to contribute socially, noting government investments in medical training and infrastructure across India.
- **National focus on drug safety & antimicrobial resistance** — Reviews of 2025 health challenges show regulatory scrutiny on medicine quality (e.g., cough syrup safety alerts) and rising antibiotic resistance as key public health concerns moving into 2026.
