


## 1. Heatwave Health Emergency Intensifies

- Multiple states issued stronger heat advisories as temperatures remain extreme.
- Hospitals are increasing preparedness for:
  - Heatstroke
  - Dehydration-related acute kidney injury
  - Electrolyte emergencies

 **Clinical Alert:** Heat illness is becoming a major acute-care burden.

## 2. Hospitals Ordered to Conduct Fire Safety Audits

- Jharkhand mandated **fire safety audits across hospitals** amid heat-related infrastructure risk concerns.
    -  **Importance:** Patient safety focus expanding beyond infection control into facility risk preparedness.

## 3. Dengue Preparedness Before Monsoon


- Experts called for **stronger dengue diagnostics and surveillance** ahead of monsoon.
  - Focus areas:
    - Earlier diagnosis
    - Vector control readiness
    - Hospital preparedness for seasonal surge

 **Public Health Watch:** Dengue preparedness is moving up the agenda.

#### 4. Extreme Heat Linked to Multi-Organ Stress

- Physicians warn prolonged heat may increase:
  - Cardiovascular strain
  - Neurologic events
  - Kidney stress in vulnerable patients


 **Clinical takeaway:** High-risk patients need active counseling during current conditions.

#### 5. Climate–Disease Link Under Focus

- Emerging evidence continues linking climate shifts with expanding **vector-borne disease burden**, especially dengue risk.
    -  Climate is increasingly being viewed as a **health determinant**, not just environmental news.

#### 6. Public Health Logistics Strengthened During Heat

- Some regions deployed ORS stations, mobile medical support, and community-level heat mitigation measures.
  -  Encouraging model for preventive public health response.
